Q: I am married, but I have been separated from my husband for the last few years. I just had a baby. The father of my child wants to be listed on the birth certificate as the father. How do I do this?



Thanks for posting. I will give you step-by-step advice on how to do this. This is a simple thing to do with a little bit of paperwork on your part.

Sympathetic or encouraging message

There are 3 steps.

- 1) Your husband will need to sign a Voluntary Denial of Parentage.
- 2) The father will need to fill out and sign a Voluntary Acknowledgement of Parentage.
- 3) You will need to mail both of these filled out and signed forms to the Department of Healthcare and Family Services.
